CHINESE EMPEROR KILLS THE YOUNG PRETENDER

[United Press Landed Wire.]

Peking, July 12.—Convinced by Taoist priests that his 12-year-old son was the rightful occupant of the Dragon throne, a member of the country gentry name Chu, unconsciously led the unknown king, himself and a number of his followers to death by marching upon Yunnan Fu, a province capital, near which place they were attacked by the viceroys' troops.

The news of the massacre has just been received here from the Yunnan province.

It is said that the priests told Chu he was a descendant of the Chus Ming, emperors, and because of that and because his son was a pretender to the throne Chu armed 2500 of his neighbors with old guns, placed his son at the head of the procession and started in the direction of Yunnan Fu to inaugurate an anti-Manchu crusade. The viceroys heard of the insurgents' plans and immediately sent his troops to meet them. As a warning to those who questioned the authority in Manchu, the body of Chu's son was taken through the streets of Yunnan province in a cage.

WOMEN GO TO JAIL AND REFUSE TO EAT

[United Press Landed Wire.]

London, July 12.—Insisting upon imprisonment as martyrs, and declaring that they would not touch a bite of prison fare during their month behind the bars, 14 women who participated in the recent suffragette riots, today refused to pay fines of \$25 each.

When summoned into court for sentence the women said that it would be useless to impose fines upon them.

"We will go to prison, but will never pay a fine," they declared in unison.

The magistrate offered to dismiss them upon payment of \$25 each, saying that the alternative would be a month in jail.

The women were obdurate on submission to incarceration.

When taken to jail the prisoners were offered breakfast, but they refused the food. They declare they will stay by the terms of their "strike," and will not touch a particle of the food offered them by the authorities.

The women were arrested while attempting to storm the house of commons recently. They were repulsed by an army of policemen, to whom they gave the fight of their lives.
