[United Press Lined Wire.] Vancouver, Wash., July 12.—Efforts are being made today to identify the remains of the man who committed suicide. The authorities think he preferred death to mosquito bites. The body was hanging far out over the Columbia river, from the topmost branch of an old apple tree, by Ernest Olson, in his orchard. To a number of persons he met on the road he remarked that the mosquitoes were something awful in size and numbers. He went a few hundred yards down the river, when he could get no further, on account of the back water of the Columbia river, which was receding and leaving large pools of water on the ground, forming an ideal breeding place for mosquitoes. He was driven into an old cabin of a steamboat. Here he smoked a long time, apparently in an attempt to smoke the mosquitoes out. In the soft ground were tracks where the man had walked, stamped and jumped up and down in agony of bites from the pests. Driven to desperation, he found a heavy fish line, sought a tree and hanged himself.
