The telegram read: "Auto received. Identified him completely. Will leave for California this week."

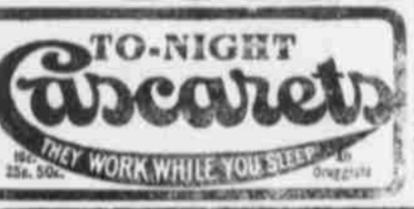

When Johnson gave himself up he said that he was not certain his victim was dead as he fled immediately after striking McAllister with a hatchet. He said he had heard indirectly afterward that McAllister had died and that he was anxious to stand trial.

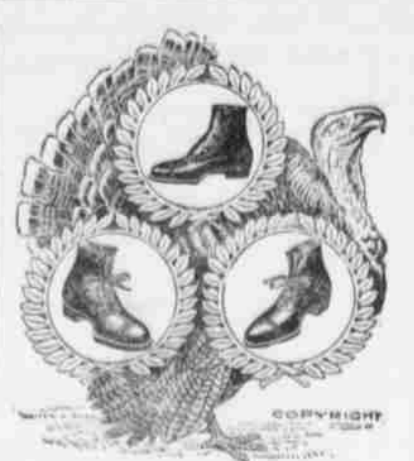
