COLONEL ROOSEVELT DOES CHURCH AND LODGE WORK

(By Warrington Dawson, staff correspondent of the United Press.) Nairobi, B. E. A., Aug. 2.—Col. Roosevelt has been devoting the past few days to church and philanthropic works with the same energy he displayed while hunting big game in the jungles.

Yesterday he took the leading part in the installation work of the local Masonic lodge. Masons throughout this section of British East Africa attended the installation.

On Sunday the colonel attended the Scotch church here and held an impromptu reception at the close of the services. Later in the day he made the opening subscription for a projected Y. M. C. A. here.

The party will depart next Thursday for Nairobi, stopping a short time at Kiljabe. At that point the American ex-president will lay the cornerstone of the new building of the African Inland Mission, an American institution.

DEER SEASON

OPEN AUGUST 1

Unlawful to Use Dogs—Cannot Sell Venison—Limit Five Bucks.

The deer season opens on August 1 and continues open until November 1.

Buck deer only can be killed. Female deer are protected at all times. It is unlawful to hunt between one hour after sunset and one-half hour before sunrise.

It is unlawful to sell or offer for sale, barter or exchange any deer or the meat of any deer. Fine \$50 to \$250, or imprisonment for 60 to 90 days, or both fine and imprisonment.

It is unlawful to hunt or pursue deer with dogs, or to watch or lie in wait upon or near runways, wet or dry stands, trails, creeks or rivers that deer are accustomed to use either when pursued by dog or dogs or when changing their feeding grounds, or when going or coming to water, with intent to take, kill or injure any deer.

Unlawful to mutilate the carcass to disguise the sex.

Limit of kill, five buck deer in any open season.

A hunter can procure for a justice of the peace a tag for each of his five deer killed by himself by making an affidavit before the justice or the county clerk that he killed the deer, by attaching this numbered tag to the deer hide he can ship or sell the skin.

Unlawful to kill or have in possession any spotted fawn or deer of the first year.

If shall be unlawful for any person at any time to enter any standing or growing grain, or upon any enclosed premises not the property of person entering into or upon the same, with intent to catch, secure, take or kill any bird, wild fowl or wild animal protected by law, or to permit any dog or dogs with which such persons may be hunting to do so for such purposes without permission of the owner or person in charge of such premises. Fine \$50 to \$150 or imprisonment five to 90 days, or both fine and imprisonment.

THE CZAR AND CZARINA VISIT KING EDWARD

(United Press London Wire.) Cowles, Isle of Wight, Aug. 2.—Guarded by four French cruisers, ten destroyers and a fleet of Russian warships, the czar and czarina of Russia, aboard the imperial yacht Standart, arrived at Cowles today. As the Standart was escorted to her anchorage by British, Russian and French warships, the Mediterranean British fleet, anchored in the roadstead, fired a salute.

King Edward and Queen Alexandra, on board their own yacht, the Alexandra, visited the Standart immediately after it anchored. They were accompanied by a full staff of naval officers.

Visits were exchanged by the Russian and British monarchs and their staffs during the day.
