WHERE THE MONEY GATHERS

A striking object lesson of the wealth accumulated in New England was given by Congressman Hill of Connecticut, while the income tax constitutional amendment was up in the house. To show where the burden would fall if an income tax should be enacted he told what happened through the enforcement of the inheritance tax that was in force from 1900 to 1902.

"The last full year of that tax," he said, "showed as follows: The state of New York paid \$1,608,000 of it; the collection district of Connecticut and Rhode Island, \$660,000; Pennsylvania, \$641,000; Massachusetts, \$559,000; Illinois, \$325,000, making all told in those five collection districts \$3,795,000 that was raised out of a total of \$4,842,000.

"Let me give you a more startling illustration than that. Take the collection district including Connecticut and Rhode Island. That district paid \$660,753 of that inheritance tax in the year ending June 30, 1902. How many other states did it take to equal that amount? They were: Alabama, Arkansas, Colorado, Wyoming, Florida, Georgia, Territory of Hawaii, Indiana, Kansas, Oklahoma, Indian Territory, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, Michigan, Minnesota, Nebraska, New Mexico, Arizona, North Carolina, South Carolina, North Dakota, South Dakota, Oregon, Washington, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia, West Virginia, Wisconsin, California, Nevada, Missouri, New Jersey and Ohio.
