FIVE ARE KILLED BY DYNAMITE EXPLOSION

[United Press Leased Wire.] Vancouver, B. C., Aug. 17.—Word was received in this city today of an explosion which wrecked the dynamite house of the Western Explosives Company, Ltd., yesterday and caused the death of five men. News of the disaster was brought in by James Reilly, who is employed at the works. He says that Wm. Sellers, an American, and four Chinese were the victims, their bodies being torn to fragments by the powerful explosive. The building in which the explosion occurred was demolished. The cause of the explosion is a mystery as every precaution had been taken to prevent an occurrence of the kind.

THINKS VERDICT WILL BE "ACCIDENTAL DEATH"

[United Press Leased Wire.] Washington, Aug. 17.—Whether J. N. Sutton, of the United States marine corps, was murdered, committed suicide, or met his death accidentally will not be known for some days.

The verdict will not be made public until Winthrop finishes reading the testimony. It is generally believed here that the verdict will be that of accidental death.

A strong sentiment demanding a general investigation of the conditions in the navy and marine corps at the time of Sutton's death is prevalent here.
