Seattle, Aug. 18.—The strains of "De Wacht am Rhein" and other airs dear to the hearts of the German people echoed through the grounds of the Alaska-Yukon-Pacific exposition today when a large outpouring of Teutons did honor to the Fatherland in celebration of the day set apart for them.

There were exercises in the auditorium, athletic contests in the stadium, drills and tableaux, prize singing and chorus ensemble, oratory and a concert.

Large delegations of Germans have arrived from Portland, Bellingham, Tacoma, North Yakima, Aberdeen and many other cities and towns to take part in the day's program.
