SURGEONS GATHER AT ADEN

TWO TONS OF GOLD AT SEATTLE

A million and a quarter in pure, shining, yellow gold!

Exposed to the eyes of the visitors at the Alaska building of the Alaska-Yukon-Pacific, securely entrenched behind a double steel cage, is a fortune in nuggets and bricks.

To the ordinary mind, gold is a thing to be measured in ounces and not in pounds. And yet in this display is to be seen over two tons of gold, a pile of yellow wealth that would do justice to the days of Aladdin.

Taken from the frozen earth of Alaska by men who have risked their lives to obtain this most precious of metals, it lies peacefully inviting the wonder of the visitor.

Dozens of gold bricks larger than paving blocks, lie in the center of the exhibit of wealth. Each one of the bricks would mean a fortune.

Just figure it out; with gold bringing \$20 an ounce and brick weighing about 150 pounds, each one means \$40,000.

Surmounting the whole on a special rack are five of the largest nuggets ever found. The one which occupies the middle holds the record for a single piece of native gold. It is worth nearly \$4000.

The visitor at the exposition instinctively wonders what would be the sensation of a man who accidentally ran onto one of these nuggets. To pick up a piece of pure gold six inches across would cause the ordinary man to pinch himself to find out if he were not dreaming.

Around the outside of the display is a frame of gold nuggets in bottles. There are so many of these bottles filled with gold that no one ever takes the trouble to count them. The mind is merely stunned by the wealth.

Nicely polished nuggets are also arranged in heap about the bottom of the cage. Shining brightly in the well-lighted building they make a beautiful display.

It is a matter of interest to watch the crowds that flock around the display to catch a glimpse of the metal they all are striving for. They seem to love to get as close as possible to the pile of wealth. Many a man is

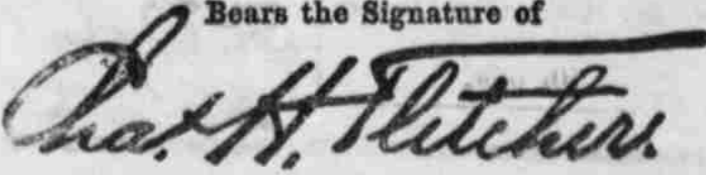
