#### MARCH OF PORTOLA AND DISCOVERY OF SAN FRANCISCO BAY

"The March of Portola and the Discovery of the Bay of San Francisco," by Zoeth E. Eldridge, and The Log of the San Carlos, and Documents Translated and Annotated," by E. J. Molera, is the double title of a history that adds to the world's knowledge of the early days of the Pacific coast of the United States The volume Illustrated with original drawings and photographic reproductions of the first map of San Francisco Bay, and also the signature of Don Gampar de Portola, showing the accented mark of the final "a," gives to the reading public for the first time a translation of important documents, and also for the first time gives events of the march up the coast as recorded in the diary of Constanso.

The story of the march in search of Monterey, which resulted in finding San Francisco Bay, is told in a most interesting and entertaining manner, the diary form being discarded for that of narrative, and the sequence of events is carried forward like the reading of a romance. Profuse footnotes and a perfect index of places and names, gives the scholar every opportunity of perfect

In the translation of the various documents accompanying the log of the San Carlos, the first vessel to enter San Francisco Bay, the quaint language and construction of sentences of the archaic Spanish of that period has been retained, adding to the romance of the history.
