MARCH OF PORTOLA AND DISCOVERY OF SAN FRANCISCO BAY

"The March of Portola and the Discovery of the Bay of San Francisco," by Zoeth E. Eldridge, and "The Log of the San Carlos, and Documents Translated and Annotated," by E. J. Molera, is the double title of a history that adds to the world's knowledge of the early days of the Pacific coast of the United States.

The story of the march in search of Monterey, which resulted in finding San Francisco Bay, is told in a most interesting and entertaining manner, the diary form being discarded for that of narrative, and the sequence of events is carried forward like the reading of a romance.

In the translation of the various documents accompanying the log of the San Carlos, the first vessel to enter San Francisco Bay, the quaint language and construction of sentences of the archaic Spanish of that period has been retained, adding to the romance of the history.

In order to secure the data for this book the authors have gone to great trouble in their research, and it was through the good offices of the officials of the "Archives of the Indies," at Seville, Spain, and the records of the city of Puebla, Mexico, that the documents were obtained, and that they were able to secure a photograph of the original map of the bay.

The book is published by the California Promotion Committee, San Francisco, and sells for 50 cents a copy.

AT LEAST TEN THOUSAND ODD FELLOWS IN LINE

Seattle, Wash., Sept. 22.—Probably the largest fraternal turnout ever made in the Northwest was witnessed today when members of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows marched through the principal business thoroughfare in honor of the sovereign grand lodge, which is now holding its annual session in this city.

The parade passed in review before Grand Stree W. L. Kuykendall, of the grand lodge; General M. A. Rainey, commanding the Patriarchs Militant, and Major-General E. P. Edsen, commanding the Department of Washington.

Members of the fraternity to the number of 1500, accompanied by three bands, arrived from Tacoma in time to join the parade, and excursions on steamers and special trains arriving this morning brought many other lodge men to swell the column of the marchers.

The Patriarchs Militant, in full uniform, lent a military aspect to the affair. Another feature that gave a picturesque touch to the parade was several thousand members of the subordinate lodges, who marched in uniform.

There are a number of special prizes in the shape of cash awards and cups for efficiency or display, and many lodges put forth every effort to capture one of these.

More than 500 ladies of the Rebekah lodge took part in the parade, automobiles having been supplied for their use. Several elaborate floats representing the Rebekahs, were in line, and constituted one of the interesting features of the occasion.

Valence, France, Sept. 22.—Convicted of 14 murders for robbery, Pierre Bertuyer, Louis David and L. Brunier, three of the "Four Chauffeurs of the Drome," were guillotined before a vast crowd here today.
