MARSH, THE MAN WHO BUILT LUCIN CUT-OFF, DEAD

[UNITED PRESS LEASED WIRE.] San Francisco, Oct. 1.—W. E. Marsh, the Southern Pacific civil engineer who built the Lucin cut-off across the great Salt Lake was buried here today.

Marsh died Wednesday morning in the Southern Pacific hospital, following an operation for appendicitis which he submitted for four weeks ago.

The greatest piece of railroad building which Marsh had charge of was the Lucin cut-off across Salt Lake which he planned and directed the construction of the 47 miles of bridge wood and fills.

IS FOUND GUILTY BUT HE STILL GOES FREE

Ukiah, Cal., Oct. 1.—Although he was convicted of murder by a jury and sentenced to 20 years in San Quentin prison, Jesse Heacock is free today because his case was decided on Saturday afternoon.

Under the law of California, Saturday afternoon is a legal holiday and in consequence the conviction of Heacock on a legal holiday was 'n reality an acquittal.

The attention of Judge J. Q. White was called to the statute by Heacock's attorneys with the result that the man was discharged.

Heacock was convicted of killing Fred Steinhart of Casper, Mendocino county.

STANFORD UNIVERSITY HAS CUT OUT ROWING

Stanford University, Cal., Oct. 1.—Rowing as a collegiate sport has been dropped at Stanford. At a meeting of the executive committee last night it was finally decided to discontinue the rowing as far as the associated student body is concerned.

Captain Houston appeared before the committee and gave a number of arguments in an effort to have the water sport kept on the regular list. As a result of the dropping out of the of the cardinal men, the college crew races on the Pacific Coast will be seriously affected as Washington and California are the only colleges to remain in the field.

COLHOUN TRIAL RESUMED TODAY

San Francisco, Sept. 29.—The second trial of Patrick Calhoun, on the charge of offering a bribe to former Supervisor John J. Furey, was resumed by Judge Lawler today.

Twenty-six talesmen were examined and rejected, the grounds for objections in most cases being either that the talesmen possessed a fixed opinion or that their names did not appear on the assessment rolls.

District Attorney Langdon declared that neither politics nor Mor's illness could affect the case of the defendant.

The final argument of the matter will come up tomorrow, when it will be settled.
