lute knowledge of the people he has depicted. "The Climax" has all these touches of reality which play on the heart strings of the most base, and will be presented at the Grand opera house Saturday, October 2.

None of the old familiar stage tricks are used in "The Climax" by Edward Locke, which is the new dramatic sensation that Joe Weber will offer local theatre-goers.

It is a natural strong story, straight from the shoulder and convincing. It grips you every minute. Underneath it all is the accomplishment of most exquisite music from the inventive brain of Joseph Carl Brüll.

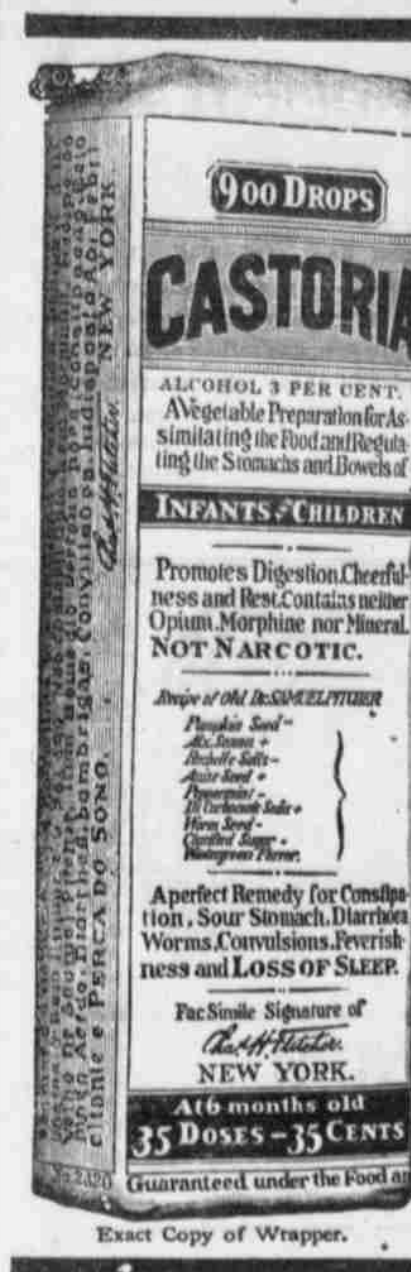
