AFTER SEVEN YEARS

HE KILLS HIS MAN

Grand Junction, Colo., Oct. 5.—After trailing his victim for seven years, Joe Pace, a cowboy, succeeded in killing Joseph Harris, who in 1902 shot and killed Harry Sieber, a millionaire cattle owner, and Pace's employer.

Pace is in the city prison today at West Water, Utah, where the more recent shooting occurred.

Harris killed Sieber on a cattle ranch near this city. He was tried for murder, but succeeded in getting his freedom. At the time of the Sieber killing, Pace was in Sieber's employ, and swore to avenge Sieber's death.

Two days ago Pace came upon Harris at West Water and shot. Then he rode into West Water, proudly told of his successful quest and surrendered to the authorities.

THE WORLD MAKES

RUSSIA BE CLEAN

St. Petersburg, Oct. 5.—Russian authorities, becoming alarmed at the threat of other European nations to quarantine the czar's domains, today are considering measures for combating Asiatic cholera, which is increasing in the Russian capital and the larger cities of European Russia.

Six thousand deaths for more than 15,000 cases of cholera failed to stir Russian officials into action until threats were made by other nations to take upon themselves the task of imposing necessary sanitation on Russia from without.

The plague has been spreading rapidly with the appearance of winter and now threatens the wealthier portions of the capital.

DRY'S LOSE HEARL

IN CONNECTICUT

New Haven Conn., Oct. 5.—The "wets" gained a victory over the prohibitionists in the annual election, which was held yesterday, in 162 of the 168 cities and towns of the state.

The chief fight was made upon the liquor question, and the returns today show that the "drys" have lost fully a dozen of the 97 towns they won last year. The largest of these was Winsted.

Elections were held in five of the cities, New Haven going Republican by about 500 votes. Frank Joyce, the Republican candidate, defeated James B. Martin, the Democrat, for mayor.

For the first time in five years, Waterbury has returned to the Republican column.

In the general elections about 110 towns chose Republican officials against 120 a year ago.

As this was the fifth marriage for the bridegroom and the fourth for the bride, there was not much sign of nervousness on the part of either during the ceremony.

Mrs. Cummins is a sister-in-law of her husband by a former marriage of his. They will return to Free Water to live.

SEATTLE FAIR IS

NOW OUT OF DEBT

Seattle, Wash., Oct. 5.—The last payment of the exposition \$350,000 was made today when President Chilberg signed a check for \$22,500 in favor of the Washington Trust Company. The principal of the bonded debt of the exposition was paid some time ago, and the draft given represents the interest, and wiped out the debt.

Until the exposition accounts have been balanced at midnight October 16, the closing, the amount which will be paid to stockholders cannot be determined. President Chilberg said the fair was in good financial condition, and that a substantial payment would be made.

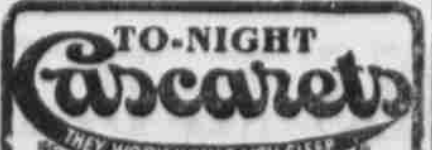
