GAME IS GREATER THAN LAW

Ball Club Sends Its Pitcher by Another Route in Order to Prevent Him Being Arrested.

Pittsburg, Pa., Oct. 13.—Tyrus Cobb, the sensational slugger and star of the Detroit aggregation of ball players of the American league, was unable to directly accompany his team mates to Pittsburg for the fifth game of the series for the baseball championship of the world. It happened in this manner.

Hughy Jennings, the astute manager of the Detroit team, learned that the Ohio officials intended to search the train either at Toledo or Cleveland, and take the Georgia Cracker back to Cleveland to answer an alleged indictment for stabbing a watchman at the Hotel Euclid several weeks ago.

Instead of taking the trip with the rest of the team Cobb started for Pittsburg by way of Buffalo, and will arrive here at 11:30 o'clock this morning. The other members of the Detroit aggregation arrived here at 9 o'clock.

PROFESSOR FERRER SHOT

Spaniards Perform Act that May, and Possibly Will, Result in Overthrow of Nation.

London, Oct. 13.—The Exchange Company's Madrid correspondent telegraphed today that Professor Francisco Ferrer, who was convicted of inciting riots in Barcelona recently was shot this morning at Fortress Montjuich.

The official verification of the execution of Ferrer probably will be the signal for further rioting in Barcelona.

Last night the Socialists in Paris and London held mass meetings to express their sympathy with the stand taken by Ferrer. Many fiery speeches were made, denouncing the action of the Spanish authorities in court-martialing the radical leader.

Some of the newspapers declared the trial of Ferrer to be a travesty of justice.

Ferrer has been imprisoned in Fortress Montjuich since the recent outbreaks in Barcelona. He was taken into custody by General Santiago, then in command of the government troops.

As soon as it became known that he was imprisoned appeals were made to King Alfonso for his liberation by the Socialists, and, upon the refusal of the king to intercede, letters threatening the lives of the royal infants were sent to Alfonso.

In addition it is reported that members of the ministry have been marked for death, and notified that their lives would be forfeited if Ferrer was shot.

Report Is Confirmed.

Paris, Oct. 13.—Dispatches received here today from Barcelona confirm the report that Prof. Ferrer was shot at Fortress Montjuich this morning.

He was executed for the alleged reason that he incited the revolutionists to riot in Barcelona recently.
