

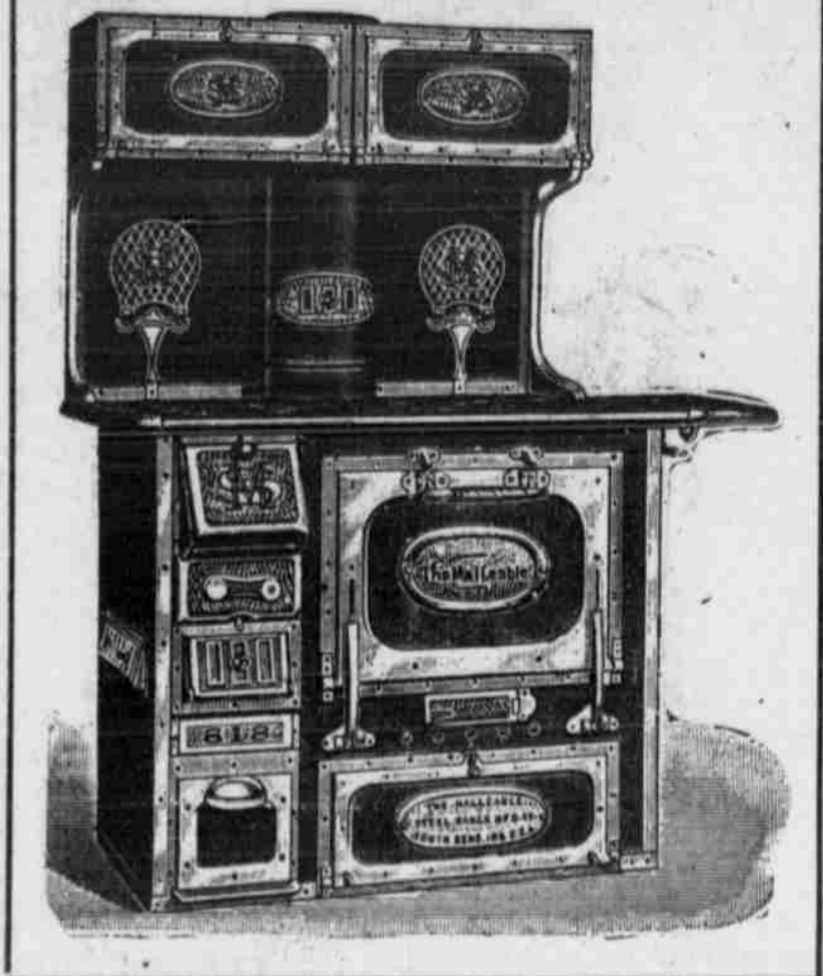

### MEYERS PLEADS NOT GUILTY

Tells Where His Gun Was Hidden and Sheriff Finds It In the Place Meyers Told Him.

George Meyers was brought into court this morning and through his attorneys pleaded not guilty to the indictment of murder in the first degree. There was no definite time set for trial by Judge Burnett after the plea was entered, but counsel for the defense and the district attorney will appear next Monday and arrange a time for hearing.

Meyers' face was impassive, and he was apparently glad to get through with the preliminary proceedings in court.

George Meyers gave Sheriff Minto the information which lead to the officer finding the fatal gun which took the life of Tom Eckhart. The sheriff asked Meyers where the gun was at the present time, and was told that it could be found in the bottom of a feed bin in the barn at the Larden home near Pratum, where he had thrown it on the afternoon when he surrendered to Rev. F. L. Larden. Sheriff Minto drove out to the Larden place yesterday afternoon, and, looking into the feed bin, he saw the sack in which was wrapped the gun and shells. Meyers had picked up an old sack while at the place and wrapped the gun and a handkerchief, in which was tied several shells, and placed the bundle in the feed bin. As was thought by the authorities, the gun is an automatic, 38-calibre, with an extra long barrel. The weapon looks as though it had been used for some time, and on the base of the barrel Meyers' initials were scratched.
