# OF RIGHT OF **CURTESY**

Supreme Court to Settle the Right of a Husband to Deceased Wife's Property.

case is being heard by the supreme court today which contains considerable interesting and importaut phases of the law and property rights amounting to large sums are hinged on the outcome and final appre and prior to the marriage of Mrs. of the case is Runyan against Winstock et al. and the respondents in the case are the sons and daughters of Mrs. Runyan by a former marriage and prior to th emarriage of Mrs. Runyan to the appellant, Runyan, she was the owner in fee of lot C in block I In Cole's addition to East Portland, but before her death she deeded the property to her children, the respondents, and the appellant herein brought suit to be declared the owner of one-half of the property by curtesy. The ciruit court returned a judgment in favor of the defendant children and Runyan now takes an appeal to determine whether a man's curtesy in his deceased wife's property is effective or whether the law overing these rights is repealed.

In the respondents' brief it is contended that the property involved in this action belonged formerly to Mrs. Runyan separately. Subsequent to her marriage with the appellant, and prior to her death, Mrs. Runyan by deed conveyed the property to the children. The respondents hold and point out with authorities that Section 5544 of B. & C. Code of Oregon. being the statute of 1884 defining or granting estates by curtesy, and Sections 533 4and 5547 have been superseded, abrogated and repealed by Section 5, Article XV, of the State Constitution, and Sections 5244, 5245 5248, 5249 and 5230 of B. & C. Code and Tenancy by curtesy in this state, is now abolished, the wife may sell or convey a fee simple title to her separate property by her sole deed, and upon her death her husband has no tenancy by curtesy in such property though he did not join in the deed.

In the general laws enacted by the legislature of 1907; there is an amendment to Section 5544 of B. & C.
