SIR CECIL COMPELLED TO COOK

Hard Hearted Wife Made Husband Do Title and Don Apron to Work in the Kitchen.

Denver, Colo., Oct. 20.—Alleging that his wife, Lady Moon, forced him to live on \$300 since 1907, and compelled him to labor as a cook on a ranch, Sir Cecil Moon, has filed a suit for divorce against her in the district court.

In addition to his re-complaint, Sir Cecil asks that the court compel her to give an accounting of \$61,000 worth of stock which he entrusted to her keeping in 1900, when they went to Europe. He claims that he placed the stock in her hands to prevent him from getting loans on it.

According to the document, Sir Cecil alleges that his titled wife left him on the ranch numerous times while she was taking race horses to Los Angeles, Oklahoma and other places, during the last year. They were married in 1888, and since their first trip to Europe in 1900 there has been trouble between them.

SALEM HIGH SCHOOL NOTES

The high school presents a marked example of the rapid growth and cosmopolitan character of the population of the city of Salem. Among the students entering the school this fall, for the first time, are eight from Colorado, five from South Dakota, three each from Washington, Missouri, California, Minnesota and Idaho, two from Indiana, one each from Arizona, Kansas, Illinois, North Dakota, New York and Louisiana.

The high school will be well represented in the field of debate during the winter. The Forum and Forensic societies are in the field again, and a number of students will compete as independents. A committee from the faculty will have interscholastic relations in charge, and Salem will take her place in the Oregon league.

From present prospects the football team will play the games during the season: October 23, Lincoln high of Portland; November 6, Newberg high school; November 17, Hill M. A.; November 25, Eugene High school.

In view of the late opening of school and the number of green men on the team the recent game with Portland academy was very encouraging to the Salem rooters. Playing a team which had already met three strong teams, the high school played a creditable article of ball. The work was at all times ragged, but will improve as the men become better acquainted with the duties of their positions. Saturday's game shows that the S. H. S. has a kick of ability, who is to be depended upon. Kaiser's placing of kicks was a feature of the game, and P. A. gained but little ground from return of punts. The H. S. attack is strong, but lacked cohesion at critical times. The worst feature of the H. S. play was the tendency to fumble the ball. This fault must be corrected, or the team will suffer seriously in the coming games.
