DE LARA MUST GO TO MEXICO

This Probably Means That He Will Stand for a Minute With His Back to the Wall—That's All.

[UNITED PRESS LEARNED WIRE.]
Los Angeles, Oct. 22.—That L. Gutierrez de Lara, the Mexican socialist leader, arrested here last Monday and charged with being an alien anarchist, is subject to alien deportation laws in spite of the fact that he has maintained a legal residence in the United States for more than three years, the period specified in the statute, is the opinion of Immigration Inspector A. C. Ridgway of the local office. Ridgway stated that the permission from Washington for de Lara's arrest was granted on the request of the Los Angeles immigration office.

"De Lara recently returned to Mexico," Ridgway stated, "and because of that he still is an alien in the eyes of the law. No matter how long a foreigner has resided in this country, if he has not applied for naturalization papers and leaves the country, he re-enters it under the same conditions a man were coming here for the first time."

Permission from the immigration department at Washington to admit de Lara to \$3,000 bail has been requested. The friends of the imprisoned man today are awaiting a reply to that request, and of the department answers favorably, steps will be taken to raise the necessary money. Mrs. A. Garbutt, who has been made treasurer of the de Lara defense league, organized by friends of the Mexican socialist, reported today that many generous contributions already have been made to the fund.

Members of the league today issued a formal call for a mass meeting at which the de Lara case will be discussed. John Kenneth Turner, author of the expose of conditions of peonage alleged to exist in Mexico, which is appearing in the American Magazine will be one of the speakers. The meeting will be held tomorrow evening in the Simpson auditorium. All invitations to be present have been issued to the clergy of the city.

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ment of the game laws is leaving us in a pretty tight place," said a French Prairie farmer, who was in the city today. "The farmer can't hunt on his own lands without a license, and yet the tramp hunter and gun-club pot-hunter, with a license, is permitted to range over our lands and shoot birds without limit or regard for sex. I have met up with four hunters in my neighborhood the past few days. Two had no licenses and two had pheasant pens in their possession. When I talked of violation of the laws they laughed. We are up against it and don't know what to do, and if there is not a shaking up of the state game warden, or some one in authority, we are worse off than if there were no law at all." The French Prairie man did not employ the most elegant language, and the above are only the milder forms of expression used by him.

If the deputies are no more vigilant and effective than in Marion county, there is no game law in effect. Those who have paid their licenses and those who have tried to live up to the terms of the law are kicking themselves.
