REFUSES TO PROSECUTE DR PERRIN

Perrin Was Jointly Indicted With John A. Benson, Who Is Serving Time for Fraud.

[UNITED PRESS LEASED WIRE.] San Francisco, Oct. 27.—Acting under orders from Attorney-General Wickersham, Assistant United States Attorney Black has entered a nolle prosequi in the case of the two indictments against Dr. Edward B. Perrin for conspiracy to violate the laws of the United States. With John A. Benson, Dr. Perrin was jointly indicted in the two indictments, and both were convicted under these by a jury sitting before Judge DeHaven, and each was sentenced to serve one year in the county jail and pay a fine of \$1000.

Appeals were taken, Benson contending the insufficiency of the indictments, and Perrin claiming error of the court below in refusing to admit a certain affidavit in evidence.

Perrin's contention met some favor and judgment was reversed and a new trial granted him. In the meantime, it is claimed, the activity of Dr. Perrin's friends in Washington is said to have endangered confirmation of Robert Devlin's reappointment as United States attorney. In fact the senate adjourned before it was confirmed, though Devlin appeared before the senate committee in Washington and disclaimed any personal conduct of the case. Perrin's friends, having set up the claim that the physician was convicted on perjured testimony of Snell, a timber cruiser. Snell is now before the police court on seven charges of perjury.
