The sale of the steamers is part of the plan to wind up the affairs of the Metropolitan Steamship Company by the legal purchasers of the property at the necent foreclosure sale.

The interests represented by Chas W. Morse were the last owners of the Metropolitan line, which extends from Boston to New York, going into a receiver's hands in 1908.
