Washington, March 19.—According to a cablegram received by the navy department today, bubonic plague has broken out in the Hawaiian Islands.

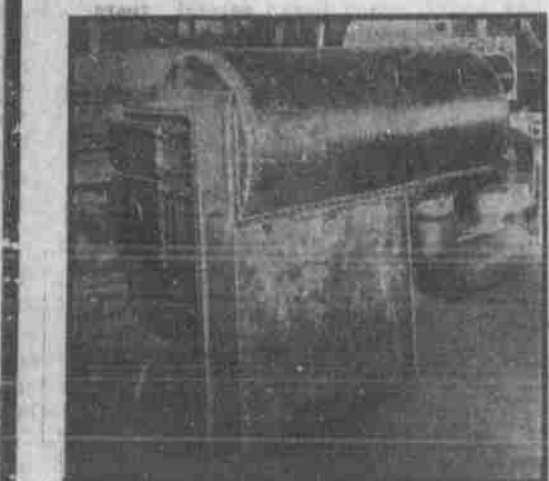

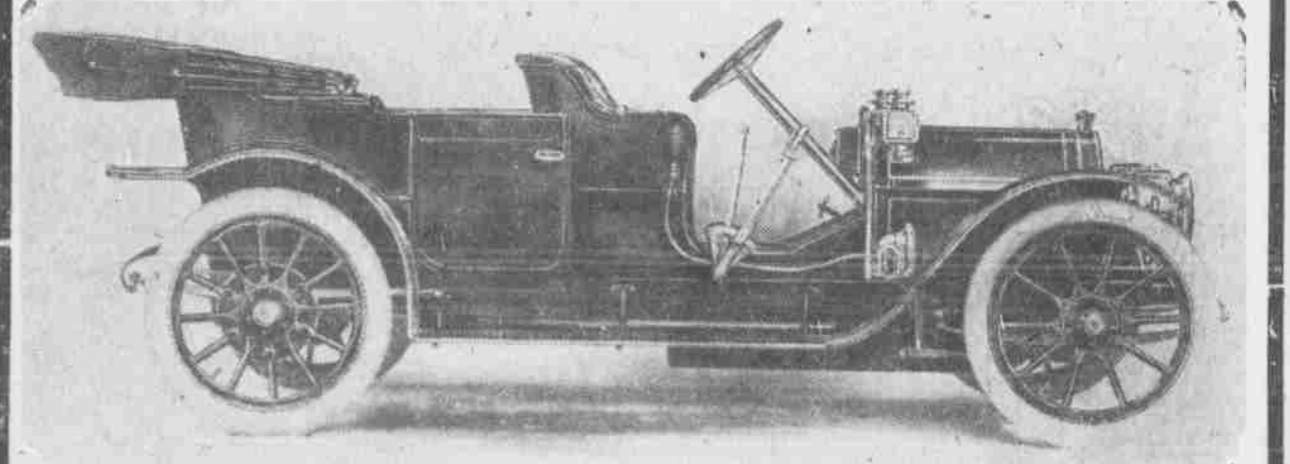
