Portland, Ore., March 31.-Big wool growers of Eastern Oregon and Washington have determined to ship their wool to London direct, in the hope of securing better values for their product than in the United States, according to information reaching here today.

The woolmen assert that prices are better in the English market on account of the absence of tariff. They claim that the tariff talk set up by American woolen mill owners is an attempt merely to force down the buying price of wool while making no reductions on the price of woolen


