

THE BONDING PROPOSITION FAILED TO PASS

ONLY 392 VOTES CAST IN THE CITY AND 150 OF THESE AGAINST—THOSE WHO COULD NOT FIND TIME TO VOTE CAN FIND TIME TO WADE—OR GO AROUND.

Because of the lack of just 20 votes, the vote standing 242 for and 150 against the proposition of bonding the city for the sum of \$50,000 for the repair of damaged bridges and the construction of those washed away in the spring flood was defeated Saturday and if any bridges are built at all now it will be up to the council to take advantage of the emergency clause in the charter.

Under the emergency clause of the city charter, the council is empowered to spend \$20,000 for bridges. The council has already authorized \$10,000 for the purpose and that would give the city \$30,000 to build bridges with.

At the examination he was represented by Attorney D'Arcy, who contended that there was a conspiracy on the part of certain teachers to oust Yoder from his position. Evidence was introduced along that line, and also as to the good character of Yoder.
