Mexico City, May 1.-That International complications will result from the killing of Olsson Soffer millionare, former professor of the university of California, was considered almost inevitable by diplomats here today. Soffer, with his Japanese serwho held up the week-end Cuerna- said. vaca special near Cuernavaca, 70 miles west of Mexico City. Details received today were that Soffer was killed in cold blood because he protested against the action of the rebels in forbidding trainmen to go back and flag a freight train which was following the special.

Soffer was a native of Finland, but a Swedish subject. Russian minister Stalowsli has cabled a vigorous protest to Soffer's government
