ROUTINE BUSINESS OF COUNCIL

Evidently believing that the improvement of Oaks Addition will progress more rapidly by being done under their own management than that of the council with all its dilatory tactics which are always in evidence when a question of improvement is involved the property owners of the addition last evening through Attorney Richardson petitioned the council to be permitted to improve the addition and their petition was granted.

Attorney Richardson stated that it was the purpose of the owners to improve the addition with cement sidewalks, hard surface streets, gas and water mains, and that if the council did not see fit to have this covered in one set of specifications that he would ask that the property owners be permitted to select their own engineer and allow him to go ahead with the improvements. Engineer Culver will probably be the man selected by the property owners.

Petitions Granted.
The petition of property owners for a grade on Church street between Court and Chemeketa was granted, and so was a petition by property owners near the Turner road for permission to build a bridge in that section.

A resolution was passed directing the street commissioner to build a cement cross walk in front of Block 1 on Union street.

By resolution it was ordered that Chemeketa from Water to Fourteenth

be paved with Bitulithic pavement. A resolution relating to the laying of sidewalks on Mission streets in South Salem was referred to the alderman representing that section.

A petition asking for the pavement of Market street from Sixth street to the tracks of the Oregon & California railroad company with gravel was referred to the street committee.

Similar action was taken with reference to a remonstrance against the pavement of Fir from Letelle to Owen street committee.

Wm. P. Lord, and other property owners submitted a remonstrance against the laying of sidewalks on Liberty and it was referred to the street committee.

Specifications for the paving of Center street with concrete were adopted and the bid for paving North Cottage from Court to Mill Creek with bitulithic was awarded to the Warren Construction company.

Bids Opened.
Bids for supplying the city with wood were opened. P. Dennis offered to supply the city with 175 cords of second growth fir at \$4 per cord; G. H. Tracy offered to supply it with a similar amount and the same kind of wood for \$4.25 or green slabs at \$2.75 or dry slabs at \$3.25, and the Salem Fuel Yards offered to supply 175 cords of second growth fir at \$3.94 a cord. The bids were referred to the building committee.

FELL OFF THE WATER WAGON ONCE MORE

COUNCIL FILED FROM LAFKY BILL PROPOSING TO BUY CITY WATER WORKS—LIKE A CAT WOULD FROM A SUMMER SHOWER OR A SPRINKLING CART.

Like a ghost arising from the vast cemetery of the past to remind the mossback element of the council that just a week ago it assassinated the city's most progressive measure—the purchase of the water plant of the Salem Water company—an ordinance authorizing the city to purchase the plant bobbed up at the meeting last night, and for a few seconds stalked bare boned through the proceedings.

Lafky Author of Ordinance.
The authorship of the ordinance seems to be laid to Councilman Lafky, and one councilman said last evening that when he found he was going to give it to the clerk he tried to get hold of it and tear it up. Just what prompted Councilman Lafky to have the ordinance prepared and introduced in the council is not known, but anyway it was slipped to the clerk during the meeting, and he completed reading it just after he had finished reading an ordinance having for its purpose the pronouncing of two persons as confirmed inebriates. Save a possible small reduction and a few other things the ordinance was practically a duplicate of the one killed by the mayor and council a week ago.

Hurried Consultation Follows.
The ordinance, for some reason, seemed to throw consternation into the mayor and his lieutenant—Councilman Durbin. While the clerk was reading the ordinance the mayor crooked his finger at Durbin, and he wagged his tail, so to speak, immediately trotting to the platform as fast as his feet could carry him. After a short consultation he returned to his seat, and the mayor had not finished putting the question before Durbin shouted: "Mr. Mayor, I move that this ordinance be indefinitely postponed," and it was indefinitely postponed, just as the securing of pure water for the city of Salem has been indefinitely postponed by the mayor and this same lieutenant.

CONCERNING SANITATION OF SCHOOLS
With a view of bringing the sanitation of the schools in the state in general to a higher standard, State Superintendent of Public Instruction Alderman has asked that annual meetings be held in all of the school districts on June 19, and that at that time the school grounds and the buildings be thoroughly inspected and that a report be made to the state board of education.

Besides being turned over to the state board of education the reports will also be turned over to the state committee of the department of school patrons of the National Educational Association. This committee held a meeting Saturday afternoon and discussed plans for the convention of the national association, which will be held in San Francisco in July.

MAKING HEADWAY
There was a meeting of the building committees of the several Masonic orders Monday evening to take final action on the proposed construction of a Masonic building. Enough bonds have been sold to warrant going ahead with the building plans, and all the subscribers will be communicated with today by telephone or letter and if they come through the work will go ahead. This enterprise has hung fire for a long time, and it is possible some of the original subscribers have cold feet.

TO PREPARE LIST OF STANDARD COLLEGES
For the purpose of preparing a list of the standard institutions of learning in Oregon State Superintendent of Public Instruction Alderman, acting under a law passed by the last legislature, has asked that the Board on the Standardization of Colleges meet at his office May 22.

It provides that the United States Bureau of Education shall determine what colleges shall be considered standard colleges, and in the event of its failure to act, a board, consisting of the president of the University of Oregon, the Oregon Agricultural College, the State Normal school, the superintendent of the Portland schools, one person to be selected by the Independent College Presidents' association and one to be selected from the Catholic Educational association, shall meet and make a list of the standard colleges of the state. While the United States Bureau has not failed to act, its action will be delayed, and it is in view of this and the fact that there will be many graduates from the colleges of the state this spring, that action is now to be taken by the board.

STREET PAVEMENTS.
The Various Kinds in General Use Today Compared Upon and Compared.
(By Col. J. W. Howard, of New York the leading pavement expert of the United States.)
Macadam roadways are suited only for suburban and outlying districts. When in the interior of a town, they become dusty, muddy and quickly worn out. Macadam is the most expensive of all pavements to keep in repair, even under moderate conditions of weather and traffic. The total cost of a macadam pavement including first cost and maintenance, is generally greater than that of permanent pavements of other materials.

Bitulithic pavement is a form of bituminous pavement made with special mixtures, prepared by special machinery. Bitulithic practically consists in a foundation of either concrete or crushed stone cemented with a bituminous cement. Its wearing surface is a very dense mixture of graded, comminuted, crushed stone, etc. mixed with a bituminous cement. This is a successful form of pavement which is durable, dense, slightly elastic and not slippery. It is suited to many streets and will sustain business traffic as well as the same time it permits pleasure carriages and automobiles to travel at fast speeds without slipping.
