### OFFICIAL PROGRAM--THURSDAY.

- 10:30 a. m., civic and industrial parade; form on Liberty street, north of Center.
- 2--Officials, Dave Yantis, grand master of parades; Charles Yankke, announcer of parade events.
- 3--Mounted marshals, D. W. Gibson, Dr. H. S. Stone, Dr. W. J. Patterson.
- 4--Official line of march. Parade starts promptly at 11 a. m. and proceeds South on Liberty to Court West on Court to Commercial South on Commercial to Ferry East on Ferry to Liberty North on Liberty to Court East on Court to Twelfth South on Twelfth to State West on State to Commercial North on Commercial to Marion Square.
