## A LONG DRAWN OUT SUIT IS AT LAST ENDED

**SUPREME COURT DECIDES CASE OF KREBS HOP CO. AGAINST T. A. LIVESLEY & CO.—SEVERAL OTHER CASES ARE DECIDED.**

When the supreme court this afternoon handed down a decision denying the appellants a rehearing in the case of the Krebs Hop company against T. A. Livesley & Co., defendant and appellant, there came to an end, at least so far as this concerned, all litigation between these parties in the supreme court.

The suit was instituted by the Krebs Hop company for the purpose of obtaining damages for the violation of a contract, and in one form or another it has bobbed up in the supreme court seven or eight times. Several months ago the supreme court decided in favor of the Krebs company, and a rehearing was given Livesley & company, and now the court dismisses that.

The question involved was that of damages. When the plaintiff delivered the hops the defendant offered eight cents when the contract provided for 14 cents, while the market price was seven cents. The defendant claimed that plaintiff should have accepted the offer, making a difference in damages of \$1,000. The supreme court adheres to its former opinion, maintaining that the rule for damages is the difference between the market price and the contract price.
