pulpit in fiery and scathing terms. He held forth eloquently on such topics as crime waves, political corruption and white slavery. Richeson's favorite theme was bitter denunciation of men who betrayed women. A number of the older members of his congregation resigned, not liking his methods, but the preacher was very popular among the younger church goers. Richeson is tall, graceful and athletic with passionate eyes and dark hair, which he combs back romantically—an embodiment of a type to fascinate and attract the unsophisticated of the other sex.

Hanged in Effigy.
 Hyannis, Mass., Oct. 21.—That the sentiment of the residents of this place, the home of Avis Linnell, is strongly inflamed against Rev. Richeson, her alleged slayer, is shown by an effigy of the accused clergyman which, until noon today, swung from an elm tree before the Baptist church where the minister first met the girl whose romance with him ended in a pitiful tragedy. The figure was hung last night at the holding of the regular weekly prayer meeting. Inside the little church 100 people, rugged and simple hearted fisher folk, who had known Avis Linnell since she was a pretty little infant, prayed fervently to heaven that the unfortunate girl would be forgiven any sin of which she had been guilty, and would find eternal peace with God. Then with determined men, the villagers arose from their knees and marched from the church in a body. Speaking no word but with faces set grimly to their purpose they halted at a quiet signal from their leader in front of an outbuilding, while one of their number went inside and brought forth an effigy clad in the ministerial black. It bore two placards inscribed with ominous talismans. One said: "Guilty, Rev. C. V. T. Richeson—See Luke 17: 3." It were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and that he be cast into the sea, lest he offend these little ones." The other read simply: "The vigilance committee." Silently a rope was produced and noosed about the figure's neck. The loose end was thrown over a limb of the elm, and the effigy left dangling 15 feet from the ground. After securing the rope the crowd dispersed with the same unceremonious silence.

This Seems Conclusive.
 Boston, Oct. 21.—Evidence which he claims will hang Rev. Clarence Richeson for the murder of Miss Avis Linnell, was unearthed here today by Chief Inspector Dugan, who declared positively that he has found a girl friend of Miss Linnell who told him that she had lunched with the minister at 2 o'clock that afternoon. If this be proved, it means that the police have forged the final link in the chain of circumstantial evidence about the imprisoned pastor. Richeson declared that he did not see Miss Linnell on Saturday.
