such symptoms should adopt a treatment designed to tone up the organs and restore their healthy functions. Have this prescription filled. Viburnum prunifolium 1 oz., tincture cadomene comp. 1 oz., syrup hypophosphites 6 ozs. Mix and take a teaspoonful every 3 hours, following it with a glass of water. This makes a splendid tonic for nervous, "run-down" condition.

Pootsore:—Being on your feet so many hours each day is responsible for the suffering which you endure. The best relief and cure for tired aching, swollen and sore feet, accompanied by burning or perspiring, is as follows: To a gallon of hot water add a teaspoonful of antiseptic vilans powder and a tablespoonful of salt. Immerse the feet each night for 15 to 20 minutes and soon you will be free from suffering the agonies of tender feet.

Rheumatic M.:—In the treatment of rheumatism you should first regulate the diet. Discontinue coffee and tea. Omit almost entirely all meat diet; also, starches, such as fresh bread, pastry, puddings and potatoes, except baked. Always eat less than the appetite craves. Restore good Asthma Victim:—The disease of asthma is probably one of the most difficult to cure, and I offer the following only as a relief measure but I have had many reports from patients who seem to have obtained permanent cures. For quick relief, put a teaspoonful of pure essence mentho-laxene into a pint of boiling water and inhale the fumes.

Distressed Anna:—The symptoms bearing down pains, cramps, headache, fainting spells, weariness, all indicate that the delicate organs of your sex are not in normal healthy condition. Any woman who feels

Mix and shake well, taking a teaspoonful after each meal and one at bedtime. Drink much pure water.

## RECOVERED ONE DOLLAR AS DAMAGES

After deliberating over the evidence adduced in the case of Frank H. Ward against E. Erwin, poundmaster of the city, the jury returned a verdict in favor of the plaintiff yesterday for the sum of \$1.

Howard was a member of a street gang of prisoners of which Erwin had charge last summer. When attempting to escape Erwin fired at him, the bullet hitting his toe. Howard commenced an action against him asking for \$100 damages.

Judge Kelly, in instructing the jury, stated that, under the law, Erwin had no right to fire on Howard, as he was only guilty of a misdemeanor. He further stated that no officer had a right to shoot at a prisoner when escaping, where the offense was no greater than a misdemeanor.

## BRINGS SUIT TO SET ASIDE DEED

Declaring that he affixed his signature to a deed solely to please his wife, who was mentally deranged, Robt. Bassey yesterday commenced a suit in the circuit court against William B. and Warwick Horne to have it set aside.

He says that in his complaint that his wife died in 1904. Mentally she had been unsound for some time, he alleges, and one day became seized with an insane desire to execute a deed for their home to the defendants, who are nephews and who reside in Los Angeles. The instrument was without consideration, and is void, it is alleged.

## MURDERED BABY BECAUSE OF HIGH COST OF LIVING

[UNITED PRESS LEASED WIRE.] Santa Barbara, Cal., Jan. 3.—John Rech, charged with the murder of his 1-day-old baby, was brought to trial in the superior court here today. Rech, according to the authorities, admitted after his arrest that he killed the infant because of the high cost of living. His wife is to be tried on a complicity charge.

Notice is hereby given that the common council of the city of Salem, Oregon, deems and considers it necessary and expedient and proposes to construct a sewer to be known as "Lateral Sewer District No. 6," and that there shall be laid 8-inch vitrified or concrete sewer pipe along the alley through block 1 crossing Gaines street, thence through block 2 crossing Market street; thence through block 3 to Belmont street.

Also along the alley in block 6; thence crossing Gaines street; thence along the alley through block 5; thence crossing Market street; thence through the alley in block 4 to Belmont street.

Also along the alley through block 7; thence crossing Gaines street; thence along the alley through block 8, crossing Market street, thence through block 9 along the alley to Belmont street.
