CORPORATIONS MAY EXPLOIT PUBLIC LANDS

DECISION OF CIRCUIT JUDGE GILBERT SIMPLY TURNS THE PUBLIC LANDS OVER TO THE CORPORATIONS WHO CAN LOCATE IT ALL BY DUMMIES.

San Francisco, Feb. 21.—That the offer of a corporation to purchase land from prospective entrants as soon as the latter have complied with provisions necessary to obtain from the government title to such lands is legal, is the gist of a ruling made Monday by W. B. Gilbert, judge in the United States circuit court of appeals.

The case decided was that of the government against the Barber Lumber company and others for alleged conspiracy to defraud the government of large tracts of timber lands in Idaho by the use of "dummy entrants."

Judge Gilbert referred to various precedents, emphasizing the ruling in the famous Budd and Clark cases, and said:

Agreement to Sell Valid.

"The decision of the present case is ruled by legal principles announced in the Budd case and in the Clark case. Those decisions are authority for the proposition that a person or corporation desiring to acquire title to a large body of timber lands of the United States under the timber and stone act may express that desire to another, and may enter into an agreement with him to buy lands upon his obtaining title thereto, and may lend him the money with which to acquire title, and may inspect and select the lands, and that such person or corporation is not bound to inquire into the method by which the other party to the contract acquires title, and is not chargeable with knowledge of any fraud upon the land laws that he may resort to, and on taking title based upon the issuance of final receiver's receipts to the entryman without knowledge of such frauds or facts sufficient to put one upon inquiry, such person or corporation is an innocent purchaser of the land."

210 Claims Involved.

The case grew out of the filing of applications of 210 entrymen on Boise Basin, Crooked River and Six-Four lands in Idaho in 1901-02. The defendants were the Barber Lumber company, James T. Barber, Sumner G. Moon, William Sweet, John Kincaid, Louis M. Pritchard, Patrick H. Downs, Albert E. Palmer and Horace S. Rand. They were accused of having conspired with ex-Governor Steunenberg, of Idaho, John H. Wells and others to defraud the government.

The lower court dismissed the bill on the ground that there was insufficient evidence to connect the defendants with the alleged conspiracy.

MUTT AND JEFF AT THE GRAND ON SATURDAY

Obituary.

J. G. Eberhard, who died January 26, at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Henry Austin, in Newberg, was born near Bucyrus, Ohio, November 25, 1832. When he was four years old his parents moved to St. Joseph county, Michigan, where he grew to manhood on a farm. When 22 years of age, and, with limited means, he started for California by way of Panama. Landing there, he engaged in mining and farming in the Eldorado district for five years. In the fall of 1859 he started for Oregon, where he stayed, at Butteville, until the spring of 1862, when he started for Lewiston, Idaho, where he engaged in mining and packing. Returning from the eastern part of the state, he located on a farm near Champeog, where he resided until the fall of 1911.

In January, 1869, Mr. Eberhard was united in marriage to Miss Louise Jones, of Champeog, who died November 27, 1896. Six children were born to them, three of whom survive: Mrs. Barbara Austin and John P. Eberhard, of Newberg, and G. A. Eberhard, of Grants Pass.
