TO SETTLE QUESTION OF GRADE

CITY OFFICIALS AND PROPERTY OWNERS CONFER OVER CHANGING OF GRADE AT FOOT OF UNION STREET TO PERMIT BUILDING OF RAILROAD BRIDGE.

By virtue of an agreement reached at the conference of property owners on the west end of Union street and the officials of the Salem, Falls City & Western Railroad company, held last night under the direction of the ordinance and street committees of the council, it will be possible for the railroad company to raise the grade for a distance of one block west of Front street. This raise in the grade is found to be necessary on account of the fact that the war department of the United States will not consent to the erection of a bridge at that point unless it is of sufficient height to be above all danger from the effects of an extreme high water such as happens occasionally. Plans for the bridge have been adopted by the railroad company and the material ordered so that within a few days actual construction of a bridge over the Willamette river at the foot of Union street to cost \$175,000 will begin. The whole matter was gone over in all its phases as regards the relative position of the street as changed to accommodate a higher bridge, and the damage and benefits derived, which now leaves the matter up to the railroad company to make such proposals as will meet the objections of those owning property facing upon the street occupied by the track. As soon as this has been done, which in all probability will be before the next meeting of the city council, the two committees will make a favorable report on the matter. The change in the height of the structure will be about four feet at the bank of the river and will slope from that point to the grade at Front street. For consideration of this distance the difference in the altitude on the grade will be so insignificant that there would not be any difficulty in putting the street in good order, and at the west end of the street it will amount to but four feet. It is expected that all matters will be settled so that a favorable report on the proposition can be made at the meeting of the council next Monday night.

WILL ASK A REHEARING OF U. OF O. CASE

Announcement has been made by Judge Slater, attorney for the Oregon University in the referendum appropriation case which was just decided adversely to the institution by the supreme court, that in a few days a petition for a rehearing will be filed. Pending a decision on this petition he will make an investigation of the law, and determine in just what manner the suit can be brought so as to have the supreme court pass on its merits. Should this court deny the rehearing, the case will be started anew.

The court in making its reversal, declared that injunction proceedings when pertaining to political matters might be brought through the proper officer of the state, and the proposition is now to ascertain who that officer is. Prior to 1911 the duty devolved on the district attorney, but uncertainty exists as to that now, in view of the recent judicial amendment to the constitution.

Notice of Intention to Construct Lateral Sewers in Lateral Sewer District No. 17, Salem, Oregon.

Notice is hereby given: That the common council of the city of Salem, Oregon, deems and considers it necessary and expedient and proposes to construct a system of lateral sewers as a part of the North Salem sewer system in and through certain streets and alleys in North Salem Addition, Highland Avenue Addition, and Broadway Addition to Salem, Oregon, as a part of the North Salem sewer system. The cost of the same, together with five per cent for engineering and other incidental expenses, to be assessed on the property directly benefitted by such sewers and drains, which system of lateral sewers shall be known and designated as Lateral Sewer District No. 17, the boundaries of which are as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point in the alley in block numbered two (2) Glen Oak Addition to the city of Salem, Oregon; said point being five (5) feet east from the west line of lot numbered sixteen (16) in aforesaid block and addition; running thence westerly in said alley, through block numbered two (2) in said addition, continuing thence westerly through blocks No. 6, No. 7 and No. 8, Burlington Addition to Salem, Oregon, to trunk sewer in Brey's avenue, in the city of Salem, Oregon.

The said system of lateral sewers shall be constructed in accordance with the plans and specifications for the same heretofore adopted by the common council, and on file in the office of the city recorder, reference to which for a more detailed description is hereby made, and the said plans and specifications are hereby referred to and made a part of this notice.

The said sewers are particularly described as follows: to-wit: An eight (8) inch concrete or vitrified sewer pipe shall be laid, commencing at a point in the alley in block No. two (2), Glen Oak Addition to the city of Salem, Oregon, said point being five (5) feet east from the west line of lot sixteen (16) in said block; running thence westerly in said alley, through block No. two (2) in said addition, continuing thence westerly through the alley in blocks No. 3, No. 7 and No. 6, Burlington Addition to Salem, Oregon, to the trunk sewer in Brey's avenue, in the city of Salem, Oregon.

Remonstrances may be filed against the construction of said proposed lateral sewers and drains at any time within 10 days from the date of the final publication of this notice.
