CENTER ST. VACATION ORDINANCE

SALEM CITY BONDS BID ON BY THE LOCAL BANKS - TWO WEEKS' VACATION GIVEN TO FIRE AND POLICE DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES.

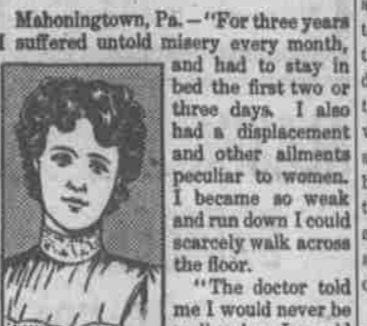
With the view of giving the Cherry City Milling company, a new enterprise being launched in the city, railroad facilities, an ordinance was introduced in the council last night to give the Oregon & California Railroad company a franchise for a spur on Trade street. After being read the second time it was referred to the ordinance committee and will come up for final consideration at the next meeting.

To Vacate Center. Desiring to avoid an interruption of the improvement work on Center street, an ordinance was also introduced at the council granting to the Portland, Eugene & Eastern a franchise to tear up five blocks of track on Center between Summer and Liberty, and to lay one block of track on Summer between Center and Chemeketa.

The company has before the council an application for a general franchise in the city, which will generally change conditions, but the committee was not ready to report upon it.

CIRCUS IS COMING WITH BABY ELEPHANT

Five years ago a director of amusements who prophesied an era of popular prices, such as we are having now in the theatrical world, would have been rated as being nothing short of a lunatic. But strange things happen as the wheel of time turns, so that today we find people demanding more for their money than ever before in the history of the world, and proprietors of attractions seeking to meet that demand. Perhaps the exception to this has been the circus, and barring one instance, all the old line shows adhere to the scale of prices which prevailed two decades ago.

The management of the Sella-Floto Circus which comes here on May 31, however, for the past three seasons, has inaugurated a new policy, no doubt believing that in doing so they could retain and hold the greater portion of public patronage.

When the simple statement is made that they have cut the regular price, which from time immemorial has been the rule of the circus, in half, few people stop to consider what this means in the regular totaling of a season's receipts. But coming right down to figures, it shows a primary discrepancy of almost \$100,000, when compared with the sum total of a season at the old prices.

Considering the fact that it costs more than \$3000 a day to operate a big amusement enterprise of this kind, one can get some idea of the risk involved when the management of the circus decided to cut the admission to 25 cents. All their rivals in the circus business expressed the opinion that such a feat of financial jugglery could not be successfully carried out, but the last three years have proved that these people builded wisely, and that from an intensely business standpoint it was possibly the wisest move they could have made. The records show that the attendance has been more than doubled, and that it is possible to give more now at the cut price and to enlarge the performance in every way than it was under the old system.

This season the 25 cent tariff will be enforced everywhere the Sella-Floto circus appears. The admission price admits patrons to the big show in its entirety, and there are seats for 10,000 purchasers of these tickets. The management followed with the statement that there is absolutely no deviation from this rule. They carry no so-called "accommodation wagons" where a greater sum is charged.

The regular ticket wagons will be opened at 9 o'clock on the morning of every performance. General admission tickets purchased at any time will be honored, either at the matinee or evening performance.

Salem City Bonds. Bids from the Capital National, Ladd & Bush bank, United States National Bank on about \$11,000 worth of bonds were received and referred to a committee.

After some discussion plans calling for the improvement of Lincoln from Commercial to John street were adopted. The street will be 30 feet wide. Councilman Rigdon favored the street being made 40 feet wide.

An ordinance providing for regulating the use of motorcycles was passed. It provides that they shall be driven no faster than 12 miles an hour.

The pavement on certain portions of State street is in need of repair and the street committee was instructed to take the subject up with the contractors—Bidwell-Hayden & Company.

Two Weeks' Vacation. Following out the practice of former years the council allowed the employes of the fire, police and also the city recorder's office a vacation of 14 days each.

Bids for the construction of a number of sewers were also received and referred to a committee.

PLAYGROUNDS MOVEMENT AT YEW PARK

The playground movement in Salem is to receive a starter at the Yew Park school Wednesday evening of this week. There will be a neighborhood rally under the auspices of the organization for higher socialization work. Principal Dotson and his assistants will put on a little entertainment program by the children for about 30 minutes.

Then Miss Bessie Foster, playground director, and Miss Wilcox, physical director, of the Monmouth state normal school, will talk and give demonstrations of the playground, folk song and folk dance movement. It will all be informal and will be the opening of a campaign to introduce the playground work in this city on a larger scale.

The parents and children are all to be out Wednesday night, and all friends of this movement are invited.

Democrats to Have Weekly. Salem—What is designed to be a permanent Democratic weekly magazine, devoted to the state-wide interests of the Democratic party, was started at a meeting of the county central committee. The magazine will be published at Salem, and the first issue will be out about June 1. —Cresswell Chronicle.
