FAST ONES  
ARE SENT TO  
PORTLAND

STRING OF RACE HORSES SENT TO PORTLAND, BUT WILL BE HELD DOWN FOR THE BIG MEET AT STATE FAIR IN SEPTEMBER.

About \$17,500 worth of race horses left the State Fair grounds yesterday afternoon for Portland, where they are entered in the racing events which are to be pulled off at that place the latter part of this month. The valuable shipment belongs to California people and are under the care of M. C. Keefer, L. J. Daniels and D. L. Bachant, of California also.

A hard surface track is the cause for the horsemen shifting at this time. While Lone Oak track is probably just as fast and equally well conditioned for training, it is necessary that the southern pacers and trotters should be acclimated and for this reason they are being carried further north. The Portland course will be the scene of several days' workout now, but the visiting horses will not be pushed to their limit for fear of laming them on the hard track. Although every horseman leaving Salem for Portland will make an attempt to get in the big money, it is predicted they will take no chances upon harming their horses by record-breaking driving over the solid course.

The real speed and heart-breaking driving will occur in Salem from September 2 to 7. Drivers may crowd their horses to the limit on Lone Oak track and no lameness or straining of tendons will result due to the springy condition of the ground of which the course is composed. Dick Ward who has a speedy string stalled at Lone Oak at present, refuses to work out on the Portland track for the reason his horses went lame last year, while Francis J., one of the fastest pacers on the coast, will receive his daily warming in Salem. Ben Walker, one of the most faithful patrons of the State Fair racing program, will remain here with his string and about thirty-five other head of speedy colts will hold forth at the Fair Grounds track until up within a day or so of the meeting in Portland.

OREGON'S NINETEEN HUNDRED  
AND TWELVE BUMPER CROP

Harvesting has so far progressed in this part of Umatilla county as to insure predictions already made of the biggest crop ever grown in the Pilot Rock neighborhood. Nor is the enormous output of the farms in the south end of this county an exception to the general rule, bumper crops being reported in all sections of the state.

In a review of the crop situation in this state the Oregonian of Monday last has this to say:

If there is any adverse factor in the situation, it is the chance that some of the crops may be so large they will have to sell for less money than in other years. The surplus to be marketed, however, is so great that the total income will be enormous.

The wheat crop this year will net the farmers of Oregon \$12,500,000. The oats crop will bring in half as much money as the wheat crop, and barley crop will produce a million. The other grains and hay will also add a vast sum to the state's wealth.

The year 1912 is undoubtedly the greatest fruit year Oregon has yet known. The total value of all fruits is placed at more than \$6,500,000. The potato yield, which is enormous, will even on a lower market bring the farmers close to \$1,500,000, and the onion and root crops will add materially to this sum.

The hop crop is going to be a great one, on the acreage, and at the present market price will give the farmers \$2,200,000, all of it money brought from outside the state. The value of the wool and mohair clips exceeds \$3,000,000.

In every county in Oregon the crop prospects are excellent and in many of them the yields will surpass all previous records. In not a single section has there been a failure. In the Willamette valley, east of the mountains and in the southern and southeastern parts of the state the story is the same, heavy yields and excellent quality.

The wheat crop of Oregon will amount to about 18,000,000 bushels. The yield will be a record one in Umatilla, Walla, Baker, Wasco, Sherman, Union, and Gilliam counties, the latter county estimating a crop of 4,000,000 bushels. Wheat conditions in the Willamette valley, especially in Polk, Linn, and Lane counties, are fine the crop in Lane being the best in 10 years. Further south the wheat prospects are also good. The oats crop of the state is estimated at 16,000,000 bushels and the barley crop at 2,300,000 bushels.

Probably the greatest crop raised in the state this year will be hay. In no county will the output be less than last year, in spite of the rains that occurred from Gilliam, Harney, Wal-

FLAX GROWING IS SUCCESS  
ON NORTH POWDER FARM

Flax growing is going to be a big industry in Powder River valley from this time on.

This has been the experimental year and the success that has been attained by a few farmers will encourage the seeding of a largely increased acreage next year.

The first to try flax growing are Landreth brothers, who purchased the big Proffitt farm of 1800 acres on North Powder.

Last spring they seeded 100 or more acres in flax and the growth has been perfect, fully demonstrating the adaptability of the soil to this culture. Next year they propose to seed several hundred acres more. Besides this their neighbors are going into the industry on a large scale.—Baker Democrat.

CHECK OF THE  
CONTRACTOR  
IS FORFEITED

For the lack of a better topic the members of the council last night amused themselves with indulgence in a protracted discussion whether Geo. Gordon should be held to his contract to build lateral sewer in lateral sewer district No. 15, and they decided—as they had decided once before—that he should and passed a resolution declaring his check given for the faithful performance of the contract be forfeited.

Because the council found it necessary to authorize one of its members to sign this contract the mayor declining because it did not contain a clause requiring that verified pipe should be used, and because alterations had been made in the contract, Gordon some time ago asked to be relieved. The council refused and passed a resolution that unless he began work under it within 10 days that his check should be forfeited.

The time had expired last night and the resolution was introduced ordering the contract rescinded. After much discussion on the subject this resolution was voted down and a check-oluted passed declaring the check forfeited. Gordon has employed attorneys and does not intend to carry out the contract, it is said, and an action will likely be instituted to have the contract rescinded and the money recovered.

An ordinance was passed accepting the E. M. Walte Memorial Fountain. New specifications for the improvement of Division street were ordered.

CHANT PUT LINDSAY  
OUT IF THE RACE

[UNITED PRESS LEARNED WIRE.] Denver, Colo., Aug. 22.—"We want Johnson," chimed at the last hour in the progressive convention by California delegates, cost Judge Lindsay the vice-presidential nomination, according to Colorado delegates who returned today. The nomination, the delegates declared, was in Judge Lindsay's hands just 30 minutes before Governor Johnson was named.

"Johnson all along had refused to allow the use of his name, as Californians had invited Lindsay to make the race," said one of the Colorado delegates this afternoon. "Judge Lindsay had promised to accept the nomination."

"Such were the circumstances when Lindsay received word that the Californians wanted Johnson and had started shouting the latter's name on the convention floor. Judge Lindsay instantly withdrew and Johnson was nominated by acclamation."
