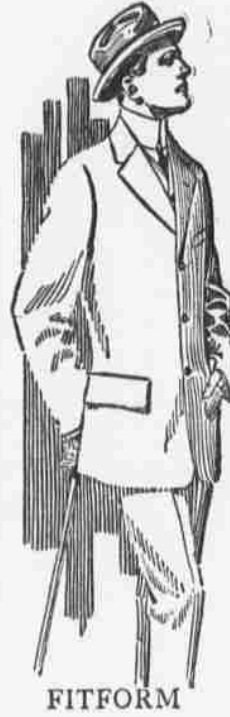

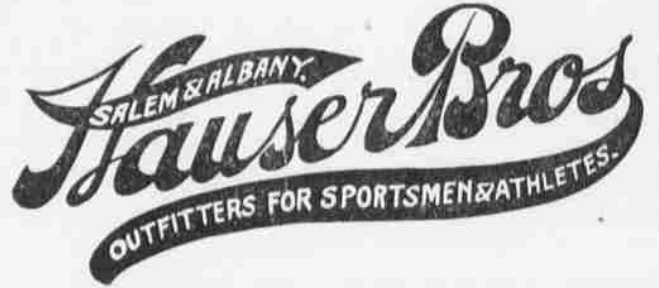

Mr. Boyer is a thoroughly competent man and will undoubtedly render good service to the county in transacting its court business in the department to which he was appointed.

To Be Chief Justice. On Monday next Supreme Court Justice Thomas McBride will become chief justice, and present Chief Justice Eakin will go to the foot of the list. The judges rotate according to seniority in office. Justice Moore is next in line.

Dana Allen Critizes Mr. Drager

Mr. Drager well knows accounts could have been kept in or out of any bank, at the option of the county clerk, it is strange that he should make such assertions at this time, without a careful investigation.

Nature of Trust Fund.

It is explained that the trust fund, in which there were rumors of a shortage, is not money belonging to the county, but belonging to private individuals. It is to be kept in any manner that the clerk may see fit to keep it. On the clerk is the responsibility of turning the money over to his successor in office. At the end of the clerk's term of office the money is not paid to the county, but is passed on to the next clerk.

Dana Allen said this afternoon that if the required amount, for which he has found more than enough funds to cover, can be determined this afternoon it will be paid tomorrow. He said further that it would have been paid yesterday, if demanded, but that it is not due until January 6.

The funeral of the dead county clerk has been set for Sunday afternoon at 1 o'clock. Interment will take place at Silverton.

HEARST SUBMITS ANOTHER OF ARCHIBALD'S LETTERS

Washington, Jan. 3.--At a specially called meeting of the Clapp committee this afternoon, W. R. Hearst submitted new Standard Oil letters.

One of the epistles, dated February, 1912, and purporting to be from John D. Archibald to ex-Senator Foraker, refers to a trust bill, which was pending. It says:

"It really seems as though this bill is unnecessarily severe, even vicious. Is it not better to test the Sherman law before reverting to a measure of this kind? I should be pleased to have word from you on the subject."

Another letter, purporting to be from Archibald to Senator Scott, of West Virginia, says: "Thanks to you and other friends, we have West Virginia by 25,000 on the state ticket, safe."
