Washington, Aug. 13.—Senator John C. Spooner of Michigan yesterday introduced the senate a bill providing for the deportation of Mexican constitutional representatives from the United States. The measure declares: "Any alien who is in the United States for the purpose of obtaining advantage of a temporary or permanent residence in the United States and who conspires for the violent overthrow of the government of the United States or conspires for the violent overthrow of the government of any other country, shall be deemed to be a rebel and shall be deported."
