Pendleton, Ore., Sept. 15.—The coming Round-Up, September 24, 25 and 26, will be the biggest thing Pendleton has ever attempted. In magnitude, splendor, thrills, spectacular feats and the prominence and fame of the cowboys and cowgirls contesting it will eclipse all previous Round-Ups and set an entirely new standard for all shows of this character. Practically every cowboy and cowgirl of prominence in the west will be entered.
