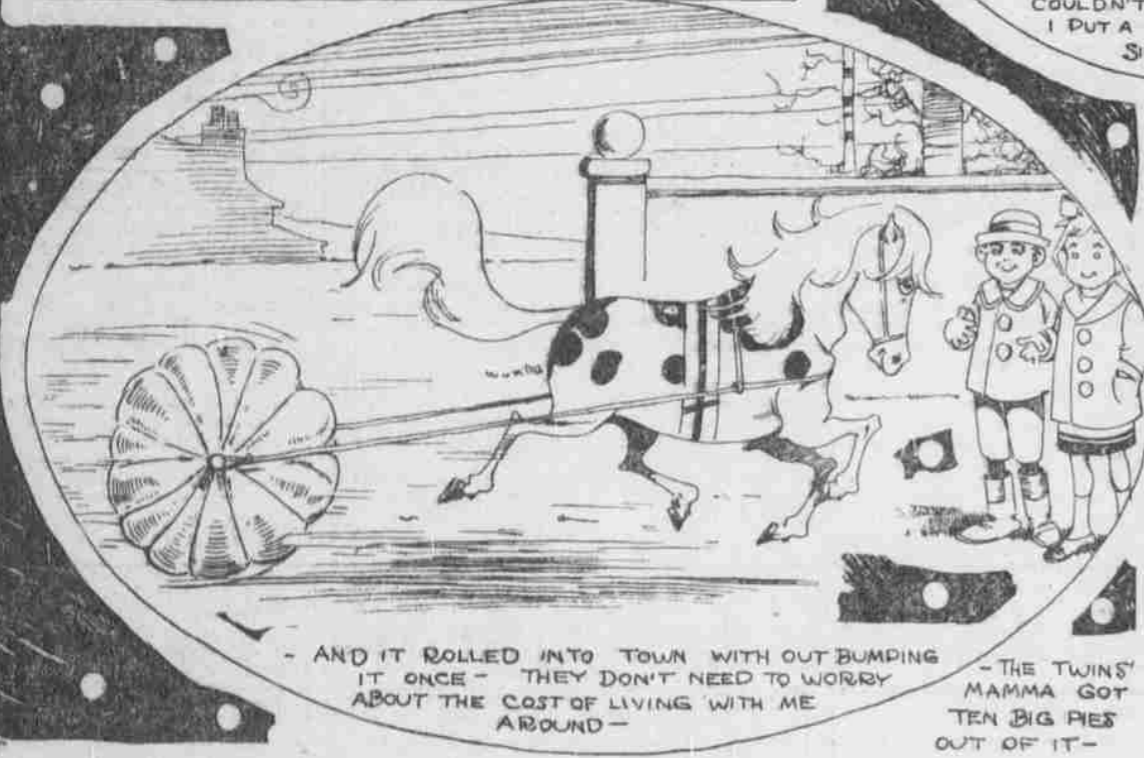
I FOUND A PRIZE PUMPKIN, YESTERDAY--

-AND THEY GAVE ME TWO WHOLE ONES FOR MYSELF.

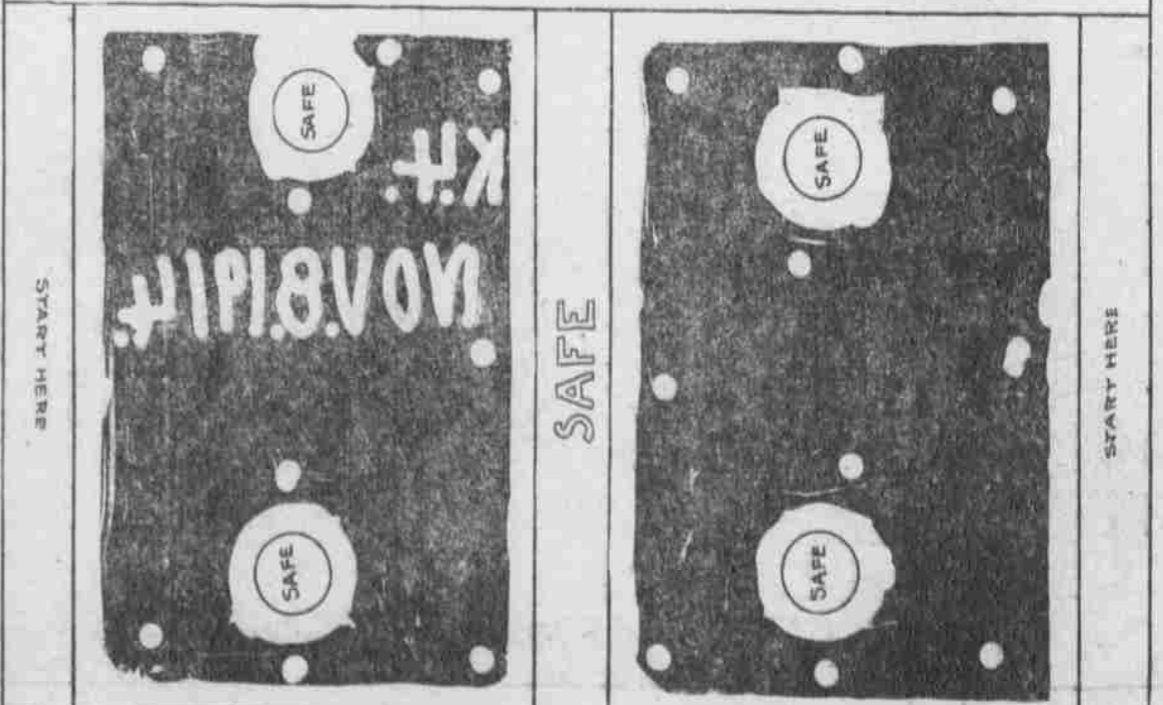
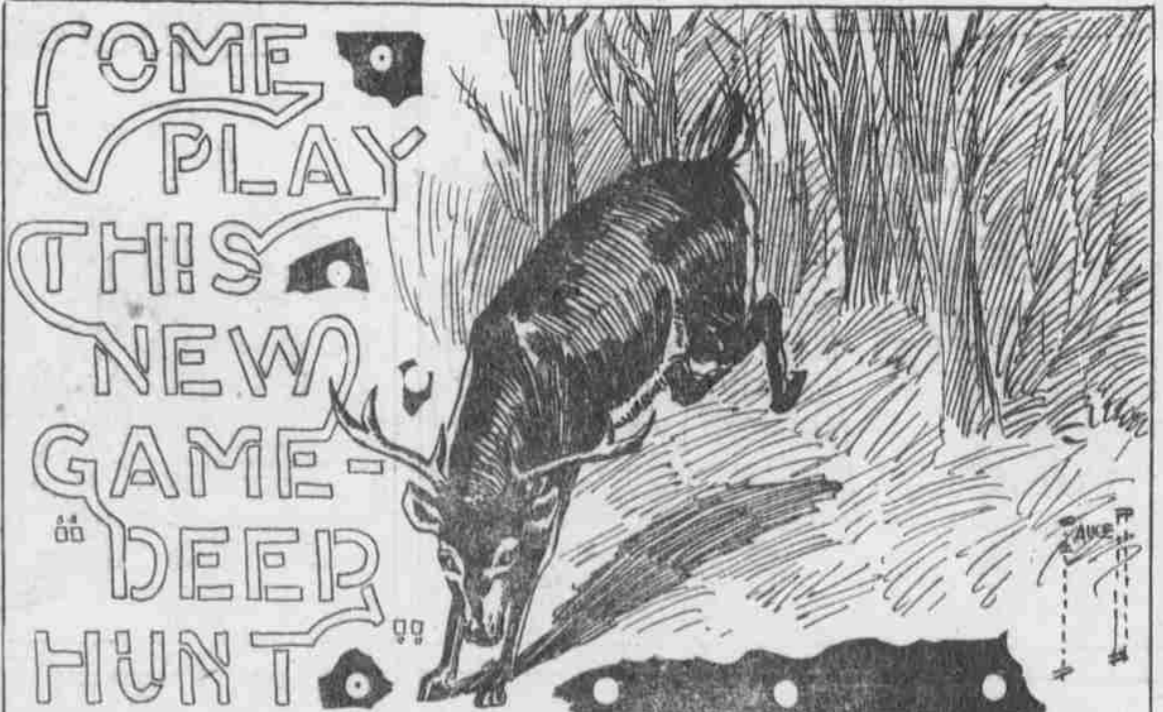
ANNA BELLE'S Brother Jack's Best Girl
