Sondheim Gone In Debt \$50,000.00

Leaving liabilities estimated at over \$50,000, D. Sondheim, proprietor of the Bon Marche, Money Bag Shop, and receiver for the D. N. Palay company, suddenly disappeared last night. A score of creditors are affected. The principal ones are the N. & S. Weinstein company, clothiers, the Fleischner-Mayer & Co., Pithian & Bar-Scandinavian American bank and the Weinstein company have attached the Bon Marche and the Money Bag Shop, and the Scandinavian bank has taken over the former D. N. Palay store, which was recently turned over to Sondheim.

D. Sondheim disappeared without leaving a word. It is said, with even his most intimate friends, following this morning filed suits against Sondheim in the circuit court for recovery of their losses through his failure.
