**Liner Lusitania Sunk
By German Submarine**

(Continued from Page One.)

Charles P. Sumner, general Canard agent, declared he would give further dispatches as fast as received. He refused to make any statement other than that the message received appeared to indicate that a catastrophe was being threatened.

A third cablegram received by the Canard line read:

"Liverpool—Following received by messenger from Galley Head, 4:25 p.m.: Several boats apparently tilted with survivors southeast nine miles, Greek steamer proceeding to assist."

It was evident, however, that each bulletin made the situation more serious, and there was an air of intense anxiety.

The Lusitania sailed from this port last Saturday afternoon. She carried nearly 1400 passengers, among whom are Alfred Guyane Vanderbilt, Albert Hubbard, Charles Frohman and others well known in this country. Just before the steamer sailed many of the passengers received telegrams from mysterious sources warning them not to make the voyage as something was going to happen to the big liner.

These telegrams, following the publication of an advertisement authorized by the German embassy, warning all Americans that travel to and from England was dangerous, caused a sensation.

Many of the friends of the passengers hysterically implored them to cancel, but so far as is known no one did so.

The Lusitania is commanded by Captain W. T. Turner, royal naval reserve, and Staff Captain J. C. Anderson is his assistant. On board were a number of British reservists going back to join the colors and representatives of many American and Canadian firms who deal in war materials.

No Official Reports.

Washington, May 7.—President Wilson had just finished lunch when Assistant Secretary Forster told him the Lusitania had been sunk.

No comment was vouchsafed.

Official information was lacking. The navy department notified the White House that it had only press dispatches.

Secretary Bryan was at luncheon when news of torpedoing of the Lusitania reached him. He hurried at once to the state department. At 2:15 p.m. no official information had been received.

The department was much upset. Every effort was being made to establish communication with consular representatives nearest the scene of disaster.

Neither the British or German embassies here received any news as to the rumored attack upon the Liner Lusitania, up to an early hour this afternoon.

The Lusitania was built on the Clyde at Glasgow, Scotland, in 1907, by J. Brown & Co., for the Canard line. When launched she was the largest steamship in the world. Her gross tonnage was 32,000 tons and her engines of 70,000 horse power. On her maiden records for the voyage. The Lusitania tip across the Atlantic she broke all was 790 feet long and had an 88 foot beam and a depth of 60 feet, six inches. She was the sister ship of the Mauretania, built at Newcastle, England, in 1907 by Swan and Hunter.

Warning Is Given.

San Francisco, May 7.—Simultaneously with the sailing from New York last Saturday of the liner Lusitania the imperial German embassy in Washington published in newspapers throughout the United States warnings to American travelers that they would do as their peril if they sailed on ships flying the flag of Great Britain or her allies. Following is the text of the warning published in San Francisco:

"Noticed.

"Travelers intending to embark on the Atlantic voyage are reminded that a state of war exists between Germany and her allies and Great Britain and her allies; that the zone of war includes the waters adjacent to the British Isles; that, in accordance with the formal notice given by the imperial German government, vessels flying the flag of Great Britain or any of her allies are liable to destruction in these waters, and that travelers sailing in the war zone on ships of Great Britain or her allies do so at their own risk."
