HOURS TO SUBMARINES

Losses to Navy and Shipping by Submarine Torpedoes Stagger English Officials-No Further Details Given Out As to Number of Lives Lost On Majestic and Triumph ---Berlin Jubilant Over Recent Under Sea Raids

London, May 28.—Staggering losses have been heaped upon the British nary and English shipping within the past 24 hours with the destruction of the warship Majestic, blowing up of the Steamer Princess Irene, and the tory pedoing of merchant vessels by German submarines.

The steamer Gadeby was torpedoed and sonk by a submarine off Cornwall it was learned today. Four passengers and the crow of 18 men were resented. Somewhere off the Irish coast the big steel steamer Argylshire is fighting for her life, wounded by a torpedo.

While the admiralty was wrestling with the problems growing out of the destruction of the Princess Irene with a loss of between 300 and 400 lives, the officials were besieged with requests for confirmation of attack on the Argyllshire. At Liverpool and other Irish points wireless signals of distress and requests for aid from the Argyllshire were picked up and vessels has tened out to assist the ship.
