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Italians Fear Reign of Terror At San Jose

San Jose, Cal., Sept. 7.—Believing he was shooting at an emissary of a black hand society, Frank Abinante, a fruit buyer, shot and seriously wounded Charles Mince, 17, before daylight today as the boy was driving an automobile through the suburbs on his way to a deer hunt, according to Abinante's statement to the police.

Mince is in a serious condition at the Columbia hospital and is not expected to live.

Terror inspired by the activities of black hand societies in San Jose and other California cities is responsible for the shooting of Mince. Abinante told the police that he had received threatening black hand letters, and was lying in wait for the emissary of the black hand society when Mince approached.

He said he was startled, and commenced shooting.

All Italians who have received letters are under arms today, and the police warned people to be careful in approaching their places.
