# CONFERENCE TO MEET

To Discuss Irrigation, Drainage and Rural Credits and Perfect Plans

(Written for the United Press by C. C. Leiter.)

Portland, Ore., Feb. 11.—The state irrigation, drainage and rural credits conference authorized by the Oregon irrigation congress, will be held at the state house in Salem, March 9.

A call for the conference has been issued by the special committee which was given the responsibility, and more than half the delegates from representative state organizations have been appointed.

The conference delegates are asked to formulate a plun for state guaranty of irrigation and drainage securities. It is proposed to draft a constitutional amendment for submission to the people at the next general election. The con-ference probably will decide whether to submit enabling legislative at the gen-eral election or, later, to the legisla-

Already there is sweeping the state of conviction that no more important gathering has ever been planned in Oregon. It will have the bigness and serious responsibility of a constitutional convention. The best brains and expensions of the control of the co rience from all walks of life and all occupations will be represented and will be called upon to produce the plan which, when enacted into law and administered, will solve the state's great evelopment problems of irrigation an


