THE TABLE

Egg Biscuit.—Two cups flour, two teaspoons baking powder, one teaspoon salt, one-half cup milk, one tablespoon butter, one tablespoon lard, one tablespoon sugar, whites of two eggs. Sift flour, baking powder, salt and sugar together. Cream butter and lard together and add to the dry ingredients, using the tips of your fingers when mixing. Then add the milk mixed with whites of the eggs, mixing with a knife until you have a very soft dough.

APRICOT PRUNE SAUCE

Half pound each of dried apricots and prunes. Cook with plenty water until well done, then sweeten to taste, and slice a half lemon into sauce when you sweeten. Cook a few minutes longer and let cool.

German Puffs

Sift one and one-third cups flour with one and one-quarter teaspoons baking powder. Now take two tablespoons butter (softer rubbed by itself till creamy); when soft add two-thirds cup granulated sugar, then add yolk of two eggs. Mix thoroughly, add two-thirds cup sweet milk. Put in the flour. Bake twenty minutes in quick oven. Use little gem pans.
