More About the Strong Points On the Low Spread Spreader

THE most critical spreader-buying farmer finds it hard to quarrel with the general design and construction of the Low Spread spreader. Arrangement of low steel main frame and mechanism cannot help pleasing him. When he buys he gets the excellent service he expects and more, and for many years, because of the many details of correct build. His Low Spread spreader continues to run easily because of the right arrangement of beater and apron drive. His horses are spared, by the independent tongue and the apron rollers. He has always plenty of traction because the rear axle is well under the load and the wheels have Z-shaped lugs. The gears that run the beater and the apron positively never spring apart, and the apron drive gears are reversible, hence double wearing. Apron driving parts are thoroughly protected by shields. These are only suggestions. To know the Low Spread you must see it out our floor.
