Captain Nopander Is Placed On Trial
San Francisco, June 29.—Captain Louis Nopander, who had command of the steamer Bear at the time it was wrecked on Blunt's reef recently, today acted as his own attorney when he was placed on trial.
Nopander is charged with negligence and unskillful handling of the vessel and is making his defense before Inspectors of Harbors and Boilers Guthrie and Dolan.
About 100 men, aged waterman of the Bear, were on shore when the vessel was placed in commission, told the court today that just prior to the ship's striking the reef he reported to Nopander that he had heard a bell off the portside.
Cross examination of Captain Nopander revealed that the partial deafness of Lieberman had led officers of the Bear to believe that no bell was heard.
Several sailors testified that prior to the wreck many soundings had been made without touching bottom and it was generally believed the ship was in deep water.
