Billiard Tournament Creates Much Interest

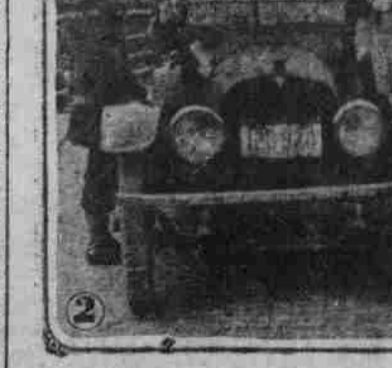
