

Delinquent Tax List of Marion County, Oregon, For Year 1917

The following list of real property situated in Marion County, State of Oregon, is hereby advertised for delinquent taxes as assessed for the year 1915, and is pursuant to an act embodied in Chapter 301 of the General Laws of Oregon as passed by the 1913 session of the Legislature.

The taxes on the following advertised real property became delinquent on October 5, 1916, and are subject to a penalty of 10 per cent and interest at the rate of 12 per cent per annum until paid and costs of advertising.

Any day after the expiration of six months after the taxes charged against the following real property became delinquent the sheriff is authorized to apply on demand of any person making application to issue to them a certificate of delinquency, upon payment of the taxes, penalty, interest and costs of advertising, certificates of delinquency shall bear interest at the rate of 15 per cent per annum from the date of issuance until redeemed.

Any time after the expiration of three years from the first date of the certificate of delinquency, the holder of such certificate of delinquency may cause summons to be served upon the owner of the property described in the certificate of delinquency, notifying the owner that he will apply to the Circuit Court of the county in which said property is situated for a decree foreclosing the lien against the property mentioned in such certificate.
