Secretary's Plea
San Francisco, Oct. 12.—"I would not give the life of one of my three boys who are in the army for the whole German empire, but if it be the will of God that the lives of all three be taken for America I bow my head in sacrifice."

That was the way Secretary of the Treasury McAdoo voiced the fighting spirit of America before an audience of 10,000 last night when he spoke on the liberty bond issue. He declared America would be called upon to raise \$18,000,000,000 this year for war purposes—\$14,000,000,000 by bond issues and \$4,000,000,000 by taxation—as an answer to the kaiser "when he ordered America off the seas."

New York City's Quota
New York, Oct. 12.—Subscriptions to the second liberty loan in New York district this afternoon were \$287,126,450. This is the actual amount deposited. This is two-thirds of the entire amount subscribed in the whole country.
