RED CROSS WORKERS ARE WELL RECEIVED IN SALEM CAMPAGIN

No Report of Today's Subscriptions Is Available Up To Present Time

The Red Cross drive for \$15,000 in Salem, to be raised within 48 hours, started with a rush this morning, with more than 300 workers reporting for duty and that number taking luncheon at the First Methodist church for the mid-day conference.

Sunday afternoon, 400 workers were addressed by Lieutenant Balston of the Canadian expeditionary force, who told of his experiences at the front with the Canadian artillery. Elton Watkins of the department of justice delivered a stirring patriotic address, telling of how this country got into the war, its present duty and the need of the Red Cross in the army work.

At the meeting today noon at the First Methodist church, the captains reported cheering results of the morning they were inclined to be most optimistic as the people have responded generously to the call.

Since the report of subscriptions published Saturday, several large ones have been received, including the \$500 from the Bush family. Others who contributed Saturday were Senator C. L. McNary \$100, John McNary \$100, Salem Bank of Commerce \$100, Roth Grocery Co. \$100, Steusloff Bros. \$100, Messrs. Stevens & Findley \$100 and Irwin Griffith \$100.

In front of headquarters on State street has been erected a thermometer which will show the total amounts subscribed during the Red Cross drive. Today noon the indicator pointed to \$4000.

Manager O. B. Gingrich, sizing up the results of this morning's work, feels confident that the amount will be raised in the 48 hours and that the people will respond cheerfully to the needs of the Red Cross.

Tonight the city council will take up for final reading and passage the bill prohibiting looting; one in regard to the care of contagious diseases; the junk shops without the parent's order, and the moving picture ordinance whereby the police matron, the city marshal and the mayor becomes the board of censors.

For the months of April and May to date, there has been only a total rainfall of 2.35 inches, below the average for this time of year.
