California Liquor Dealers Are Warned

Portland, Ore., July 6.—The United States district attorney's office issued a warning to California liquor dealers yesterday.

Such dealers responsible for activities of bootleggers in Oregon will be prosecuted under the Reed law. This law covers conspiracy to export liquor into dry territory, and prosecution will follow such offenses in the future.

The effort to bring a San Francisco dealer named Lapsie, owner of the Bohemian Liquor company, San Francisco, to Portland for trial on such a conspiracy trial will be renewed. Lapsie successfully resisted such an effort recently.

The district attorney intends to kill bootlegging at the source of the evil, and he says San Francisco is the chief source.

Oswald West Would Merge Telephone Lines

Portland, Or., July 6.—Oswald West today asked the city council to approve the proposed merger of the Home Telephone company with the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph company. West is receiver for the Home. He wishes to go to Washington immediately to get government sanction of the merger. The council will act on his request within the next two days.

The Home company has sold bonds valued at \$3,000,000. If the merger is effected the bond holders will get seventy cents on the dollar. If it is not effected foreclosure proceedings will come soon.

California investors own \$1,000,000 of the bonds. West urges the merger to protect the investors and as a war economy measure for Portland.
